Question: How is a man who hears without doing like a man who looks into a mirror and later forgets (vv. 22-24)?

Question: What might cause a person to forget to do what the Word says? Why is it easy to listen to God's Word without doing what it says?

Question: Why will those who look intently into the perfect law be blessed (v. 25)?

Question: Why does Paul say that their religion is worthless (vv. 26)?

Question: What two requirements does James present for a religion that pleases God (v. 27)? Are these the only two requirements?
