Background


"After the Assyrians captured Samaria in 722–721 BC, they deported all the Israelites of substance and settled the land with foreigners, who intermarried with the surviving Israelites and adhered to some form of their ancient religion (2 Ki. 17–18). After the exile, Jews returning to their homeland, the remains of the southern kingdom, viewed the Samaritans not only as the children of political rebels but as racial halfbreeds whose religion was tainted by various unacceptable elements (Ne. 13; cf. Jos., Ant. xi. 297–347, esp. 340)."

Read John 4:1-6 - Context

Where was Jesus traveling from and to?

Look at the map. The most direct route for the journey is through Samaria. However, in Jesus' time, the Jews would not go through Samaria. Instead, they went east of the Jordan River, then north, than west.



Read John 4:7-26 - An Encounter with Jesus

To the Samaritan woman, who was Jesus? What was her impression of Him ... when Jesus asked her for water to drink (verses 7-9).

when Jesus told her about the gift of living water (verses 10-15).

when Jesus told everything about her marital history (verses 16-19).

when Jesus explained to her what is true worship about (verses 20-26).
